<u>Dust:</u> Select few best RD's met with fair interest from the Blenders and sold at around last levels. Others were mostly neglected and where sold, eased by Tk. 5/8 from last. Cleaner Dusts sold well whilst better CD's continued to be a fairly strong feature.

<u>Comment:</u> There was less demand this week and apart from select few well made good liquoring types, all others failed to attract any interest. Blenders operated selectively whilst Loose Tea Traders showed interest on select few lines. Withdrawals were heavier than last.
