LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring types met with fairly good demand and mostly sold around last levels. Mediums sold well at firm to occasionally dearer rates of upto Tk. 5/=. A limited weight of plainer types were absorbed at around last levels. There were however, fair amount of withdrawals in this category.

Fannings: Best and below best types met with fairly good demand at generally firm rates. Mediums sold similarly. Plainer sorts met with less demand and mostly remained unsold.
