Demand: Fairly good demand at generally easier rates.

Buyers: Blenders were the major contenders. Loose Tea Traders were rather selective.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Better types sold well at rates generally Tk. 3/5 below last. Mediums were barely steady. Plainer types were easier and suffered fair withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were a good market but prices declined by Tk 2/3 below last. Mediums shed a little more. Plainer types declined by Tk 5/7 with fair withdrawals.

Green Tea: A nominal weight of Hyson grade offered were sold at between Tk. 1000 - Tk. 1150 per kg.

White Tea: A nominal weight of Silver Needle grade offered were sold for Tk. 5000/= per kg.
