Brokens: Well made good liquoring types were readily absorbed at firm rates. Smaller types occasionally inclined a little following competition. Others were firm. Plainer types met with an improved demand and sold at around last levels.

Fannings: Best types were a fairly strong market and sold at fully firm to little dearer rates. Others were steady. Plainer types met with a good demand at around last levels.

Green Tea: A small weight of Hyson grade from Champarai Tea Estate offered sold at Tk 900/= per kg.

Dust: Met with a strong demand. Clean, good liquoring types ruled firm around Tk 5/= dearer whilst the others were firm. CD's continued to be a strong feature.

Comment: All sections of the market were noticeably active this week which lead to a better demand at generally firm to occasionally little dearer rates. Well made good liquoring types continue to attract keen interest from all sections of the market. Plainer types met with renewed interest from the Loose Tea Traders and mostly sold at satisfactory levels. Withdrawals were fewer.
