Brokens: Well made good liquoring sorts met with a good demand and sold at firm to occasionally little easier rates of Tk. 2/3. Others were firm to little easier following quality.

Fannings: Best and below best types met with good market and sold at rates mostly around last. Medium and plainer types sold well at rates firm to little easier in line with quality.

Green Tea: A small parcel of Hyson grade from Brindabon Tea Estate sold at Tk. 1200/= per kg.

Dust: Met with a fairly good demand. Clean good liquoring types sold well but eased by Tk 3/5 and occasionally more. CD's were generally easier and there were some withdrawals.

Comment: Blenders as well as the Loose Tea Traders lent fair support but apparently lacked strength and as a result prices for most descriptions tended lower. Teas from the Northern district were generally firm. Dusts were an easier market as were the CD's. There were however, some withdrawals.
