LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Select few well made, good liquoring types available were keenly competed for and generally sold at firm to little dearer rates. Below best and Mediums were steady on last. Plain and the poorer types were firm to easier following quality.

Fannings: Likewise, a handful of the best types offered sold readily at firm to little dearer rates. Rest were about steady. Plain and poorer types mostly sold at around last.

Dust: Met with a fairly good demand. Select few cleaner types sold well at generally firm rates. Others were irregular and often easier. CDs were a good market, particularly the clean primary types. There were, however, some withdrawals.

Comment: With offerings showing a decline, this sale met with a fairly good demand. Support emanated mainly from the Blenders whilst Interest from the Loose Tea Traders were rather constricted. Prices were generally around last. There were however, fair withdrawals.
