LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Clean, well-made Brokens sold well at generally easier rates of Tk 8/10. Select few lines of the best type however, shed less. Medium and the plainer types eased by about Tk. 10/= and occasionally a little more and suffered some withdrawals.

Fannings: Best and the below best types met with a fairly good demand and sold at rates Tk 8/10 below last. Rest shed a little more with some withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with selective demand. Better types sold between Tk 140/148 whilst the lesser types ranged between Tk 130/135.
