Demand: Strong demand.

Buyers: Blenders operated in strength. Loose Tea Traders lent fair support.

LEAF-CTC:

Brokens: Well made good liquoring invoices were a strong feature and sold at firm rates. Occasional lines tended little dearer. Mediums were firm. Plainer types met with only a fair demand.

Fannings: Best and the below best types were readily absorbed mainly by the Blenders at mostly firm rates. Medium sold well at around last levels. Plainer types were little easier with some withdrawals.

Bought-Leaf Teas: Met with a slightly better demand at generally between Tk. 120/130. Select few better types sold between Tk. 135/140. There were however, fair withdrawals.

Comment: Blenders were noticeably forceful this week and accounted for majority of the teas sold. Prices were generally firm. Withdrawals were less and were mostly confined to the plain and poorer types on offer. Well made good liquoring types were a strong feature.
