**Brokens:** Well made good liquoring types were a fairly strong feature and sold at firm to dearer rates. Below bests were about firm. Medium and the plainer types were generally easier by up to Tk. 5/= with fair withdrawals.

<u>Fannings:</u> Clean bright liquoring types were a fairly strong market and sold at firm to dearer rates. Rests were firm to easier by upto Tk. 5/= following quality with some withdrawals. Plainer types were generally neglected.

**Bought-Leaf Teas:** Met with selective demand. Prices generally ranged between Tk. 95/115. whilst the better types sold between Tk. 120/127.
