<u>Fannings:</u> Best types sold well but ruled easier than last. Below best and the mediums sold readily at around last levels. Plainer types tended easier with some withdrawals.

<u>Bought-Leaf Teas:</u> Met with a little improved demand following quality. Most prices were firm to slightly dearer. There were however, some withdrawals.
